## **Bud Klein's Bio**

Dr. Emanuel (bud) Klein is an 89 yo Medical Doctor. My first experiences with ill patients were as a Naval Hospital Corpsman while in military service during WWII. Following my discharge from Naval Service I enrolled as a Pre Medical student at Hofstra College in Hempstead N.Y. as a beneficiary of the G I Bill. I supplemented my GI Bill stipend by working as an Orderly in the Meadowbrook Nausau County Hospital.

I graduated from Hofstra Cum Laude with Honors in Biology & Psychology.

I attended Medical School at the University of Louisville in Louisville, Kentucky. While a Medical Student: I served as President of the Medical Fraternity, Worked as a paid Sub Intern at the Louisville Jewish Hospital and worked Saturday nights in the Emergency Room of the Louisville General Hospital for my room & board at the hospital. The Medical School designated me as a Student Research Scholar.

My Internship year was served at the University of Texas Branch in Galveston, Texas. Internship was followed by a Year of General Surgical Residency as part of a three year Residency in Urologic Surgery at the Indiana University Medical Center in Indiananapolis, Indiana.

I practiced Urologic Surgery as a member of a Urologic Group in Marion, Indiana. Because of Illness I left the practice of Urology and joined the Medical Staff of the Student Health Service at the Indiana University main campus in Bloomington, Indiana. I practiced General Medicine there serving the medical needs of students, student spouses and children. I became Board Certified in Family Medicine. Late in my years at the University, the only Dermatologist in the area left the community. By special permission of the Dermatology Department Chief at the University Medical Center I spent 9 months with the Dermatology Residency

Program in order to have that service available to students in Bloomington. I was a physician at Indiana University for 31 years until my retirement.

In the Bloomington community I served as the first Medical Director of a newly formed Planned Parenthood clinic.
